

**My Bernina Classes** are classes offered to new owners of Bernina sewing machines, embroidery machines, sergers and embroidery software by Quilt Quarters. These classes are free to anyone who has purchased a new or used machine from Quilt Quarters. The classes are offered during the day, evening, and weekends. The class dates and times are listed on our website, [www.quiltquarters.com](http://www.quiltquarters.com). To sign up for the classes, the new owner can sign up at Quilt Quarters or call 317-757-8340.

**The new owner needs to bring their machine, as well as all of the accessories that came with your machine, to the class.** Also, the new owner will have received a CD containing PDF files, which should be printed off before **My Bernina** class. These files can be printed on the owner's computer or by a copy center such as Kinkos, Office Depot, etc. These files are in color but we suggest they be printed in black and white to keep costs down. The new Bernette/Bernina Sewing machine owner should print off **1 – My Bernina – Basic Operation, 2 – My Bernina - Stitch Fun**. New Owners of the Artista 640, 730, and Artista 820/830 should also print off **3 – My Bernina – Creative Options**.

**Basic Operation, (Class 1)** covers the basics of the sewing machine. We will explain machine setup for straight, zigzag and utility stitches, correct threads and needles to use, buttonholes, attaching buttons, zippers, etc. For all models of Bernina sewing machines and Bernette sewing machines

**Stitch Fun, (Class 2)** covers the stitches on your machine. We will cover decorative stitching, satin stitches, altering stitches, pattern functions, mirror image, free motion quilting, etc. For all models of Bernina and Bernette sewing machines.

**Creative Options, (Class 3)** covers different operating options for your Artista 640, 730, and 820/830. We will discuss the setup program, multi-directional stitching, monograms, and the functions of the machines

**Class Four** – Embroidery Features. For all machines with embroidery features.

**Class A** – Lecture/Demo on supplies needed for embroidery, including thread, needles, stabilizers, and accessories. Also, there will be instruction on hooping various fabrics, garments, etc. along with a demonstration on software that comes with the machines. You do not need to bring your machine.

**Class B** – Hands On instruction on embroidery. Bring machine plus embroidery module, hoops and other supplies as given in class A. For the Embroidery Features class you should print off the PDF titled “My Bernina Embroidery”.

## **Serger**

**Class one** covers care & maintenance, supplies used, threading and sewing of the various stitches available on the sergers. For all models of Sergers

**Class Two** for models with coverstitch and chain stitch.

**Embroidery Software classes** - For Artista Designer Software owners. The owner needs to bring your computer with the software loaded and with your software security device.

Quilt Quarters and Bernina both feel that these classes are important to the new owners for full enjoyment of their machines. We do our best to offer the classes at various times so that the owners can take advantage of the classes. We do add more classes as needed, check at the stores for class times. It is important for the new owner to take the time to attend these classes so that you are familiar with your new machines features.
